BAC RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE DISPOSAL OF THE COMMISSION ON FILIPINOS OVERSEAS UNSERVICEABLE VEHICLE THROUGH PUBLIC BIDDING

WHEREAS, the Commission on Filipinos Overseas deems it necessary to dispose of its unserviceable vehicle considering that the cost of repair and maintenance outweigh the services to the commission can derive from its continued use;

WHEREAS, the Commission on Filipinos Overseas requested the Commission on Audit on March 7, 2018 and February 8, 2019 for the approval of the disposal of Toyota Hi-Ace Commuter Van, 1997 model with plate number SEP-536, through Public Bidding;

WHEREAS, in the computation of Appraised Value, the amount of Twenty One Thousand Six Hundred Seventy Six peso and 86/100 only (Php 21,676.86) was derived using the Manual on Disposal of Government Property which the System and Procedures Bureau prepared pursuant to its mandate under National Budget Circular No. 425 dated January 28, 1992.

WHEREAS, the Commission on Filipinos Overseas, through its Bids and Awards Committee, issued the Invitation to Bid for the Disposal of the abovementioned vehicle, posted the same in the PhilGEPS, CFO website and three (3) public places for seven days;

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisement, three (3) suppliers expressed interest in participating in the Disposal of CFO Unserviceable Vehicle: Toyota Hi-Ace Commuter Van 1997 model. In particular, the said suppliers are MICROSPHERE SYSTEM TECHNOLOGY, OMBENG HAULING SERVICES and PANTHERTECH INTERNATIONAL MARKETING CORP.;

WHEREAS, at 11:00 pm on May 28, 2019, the deadline for the submission and 2:00 pm for the Opening of bids, the above mentioned bidder dropped bid and found eligible for the contract, when the bid were opened, the bid read passed the preliminary examination:


