WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), with the assistance of the Technical Working Group (TWG), conducted the final phase of the process of post-qualification for the Supply and Delivery of Various ICT Equipment (Public Bidding No. 2018-01-001) on the 19th of February 2018 at Citigold Center 1345 Pres. Quirino Ave. cor., Osmeña Highway, Paco, Manila;

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisement, Two (2) Prospective Bidders logged their intent of joining thru PhilGEPS namely:

- 1). BENIQUEYELLE ENTERPRISES
- 2). COMPU CARE CENTER

WHEREAS, only one (1) Bidder submitted their bid proposals namely:

- 1). COMPU CARE CENTER (submitted February 19, 2018 @ 12:24 pm)

WHEREAS, the ABC for the contract is One Million Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (Php 1,950,000.00) for the Supply and Delivery of Various ICT Equipment;

WHEREAS, the bidder satisfied the submission of legal requirements


WHEREAS, the bid proposal of **COMPUCARE CENTER** was found to be the lowest calculated bid and most advantageous to the Commission;





WHEREAS, the bid submitted by COMPUCARE CENTER with a total amount of **One Million Four Hundred Four Thousand Six Hundred Forty Five Pesos only (Php 1,404,645.00)** was agreed to be the most advantageous price to the Commission on Filipinos Overseas.

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, the Members of the CFO Bids and Awards Committee, hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED** pursuant to Section 12 of R.A. No. 9184 and the applicable provision of its IRR, to award the bid to COMPUCARE CENTER for the Supply and delivery of various ICT Equipment.


