**RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE AWARD OF THE CONTRACT FOR THE  
 SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF MULTI-PURPOSE VEHICLE FOR CFO**

**WHEREAS**, the Commission on Filipinos Overseas (CFO) posted the Request for Quotation for the Supply and delivery of Multi-Purpose Vehicle for CFO in the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement Service (PhilGEPS) website and in a conspicuous place at the premises of the CFO for seven (7) days from February 1-9, 2018;

**WHEREAS**, in response to the said advertisement, only one (1) supplier expressed interest in participating in the Supply and delivery of Multi-Purpose Vehicle for CFO. In particular, the said supplier is TOYOTA OTIS, INC.

**WHEREAS**, upon opening of the Formal Quotation submitted by the supplier at 11:00 am on February 9, 2018, the above mentioned bidder dropped bid and found eligible for the contract, when the bids were opened, the bid read passed the preliminary examination:






